4TH NORDIC AND BALTIC DEAF DISCGOLF CHAMPIONSHIPS 2026



WELCOME

The Latvian Deaf Sports Federation is pleased to host the 4th Nordic-Baltic Deaf Discgolf Championships 2026. This event will be held in the picturesque town of Talsi (approximately 100km from Riga), Latvia, from September 3rd to September 6th, 2026. Known as the "town of nine hills," Talsi offers a unique blend of ancient history dating back to 1231 and modern charm.

Autumn in Talsi brings a beautiful and refreshing transition of seasons, though the weather in early September can be quite variable. Participants should expect moderate daytime temperatures averaging between 16°C and 18°C, while nights and early mornings are significantly cooler, often dropping to 8°C or 10°C.

Since the "9Hill" course is located in an open, hilly area, players should be particularly mindful of the wind and rain, which can be more noticeable and impact disc flight.

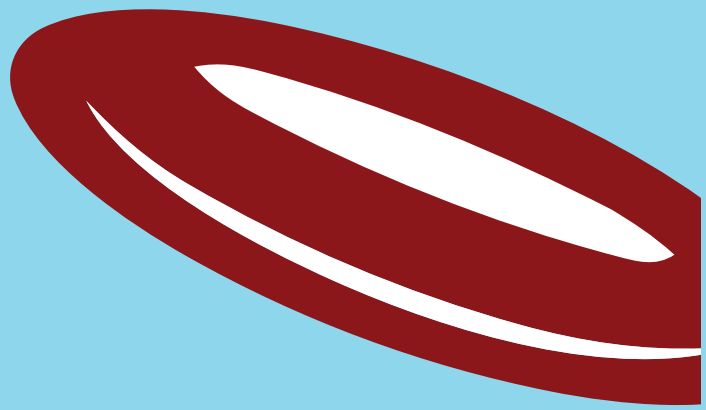

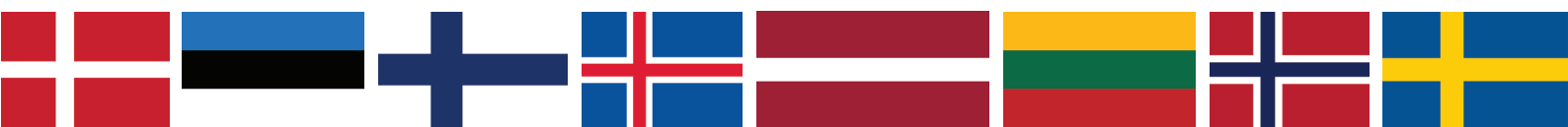
REGULATIONS

AUDIOGRAM

NBDSF together with Latvian Deaf Sports Federation follow ICSD audiogram regulations. Participation shall be restricted to persons who are: deaf, defined as a hearing of at least 55Db in the better ear. The Federation must show every athlete's ICSD Athlete ID.

INSURANCE

Every athlete and federation are responsible for their own insurance under the championships.

ACCOMMODATION

Official accommodation: Guest House “Rezidence Kurzeme”
(21 km from the competition venue)
Address: Renges, Strazde Parish, LV-3291, Latvia

Number of rooms: 25 (1–4 guests per room). Out of these, 7 rooms have double beds and 18 rooms have single beds.

The venue can accommodate up to 84 persons in the main guest house (using all available beds). Amenities: all rooms have showers, toilets, fridges

TRANSPORTATION
